Areas of Ministry Service

With over 25 years and 900 clubs operating in 24 states, FPoA has seen over 100,000 students make a commitment to follow Christ. It's a core principle of FPoA to connect every new believer to the local church. FPoA is pro-church and here's why we think this is important:

- The Center for Disease Control (CDC) reports that suicide is the second leading cause of death among high school-aged youth, ages 14-18.
- According to Barna and Impact 360 Institute, only 4% of today's teenagers have a Biblical worldview.
- Barna also reported that most teens agree that conversations about faith perspectives are most effective when a significant relationship has already been established (82%). Trust comes first.
- Two out of three born again Christians (64%) made their commitment to Christ before their 18th birthday (Barna Group 2016).
