What is 'INVITE WEEK' at a First Priority Club?

Invite Week is WHEN we share the Gospel! The setting is relaxed where food, upbeat Christian music, games, drama, etc. are tools we use to create a fun environment that welcomes visitors. For several weeks, students have been praying for their friends who don't have a relationship with Christ and have invited them to check out the club. Students are praying that their friends will respond to a simple and clear presentation of who Jesus Christ is and what He accomplished on the cross.

What we need from you, the speaker at our 'INVITE WEEK' club meeting!

1. Clearly explain the plan of salvation using Scripture! Feel free to use your favorite evangelism tool (The Four/4 Spiritual Laws, Romans Road, Evangelism Explosion, FAITH, etc.).
2. Provide an opportunity for students to respond to the Gospel by means of confession and commitment. The Campus Coach/Club Mentor can extend the invitation if you prefer.
3. Allow time at the end of the meeting (at least 5 minutes) for new believers to fill out a decision-card and get a free Bible. This element of the meeting will be guided by student leaders.
4. Agreement with our Statement of Faith (provided below).
